# BACKGROUND

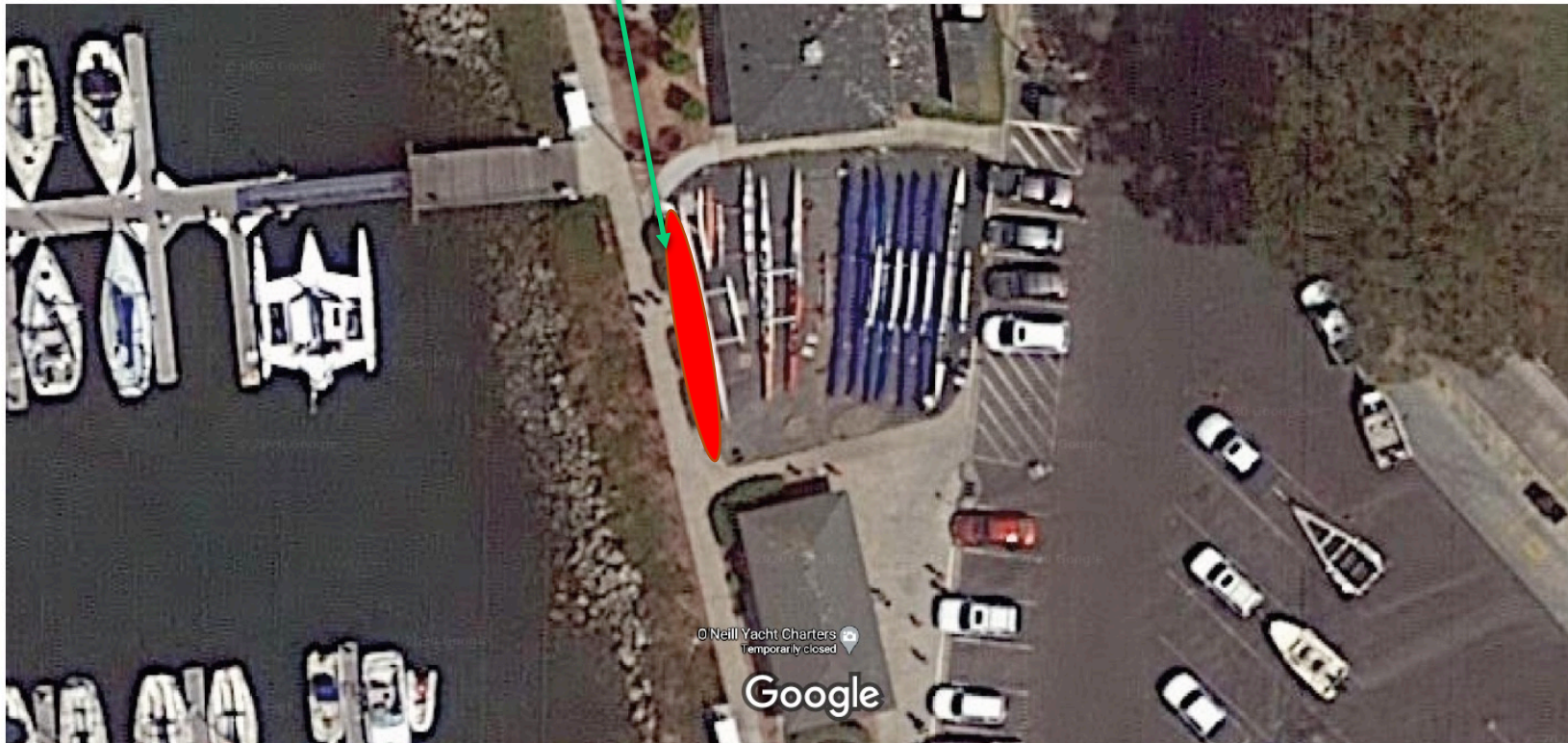
- Many OSC members have recently bought boats

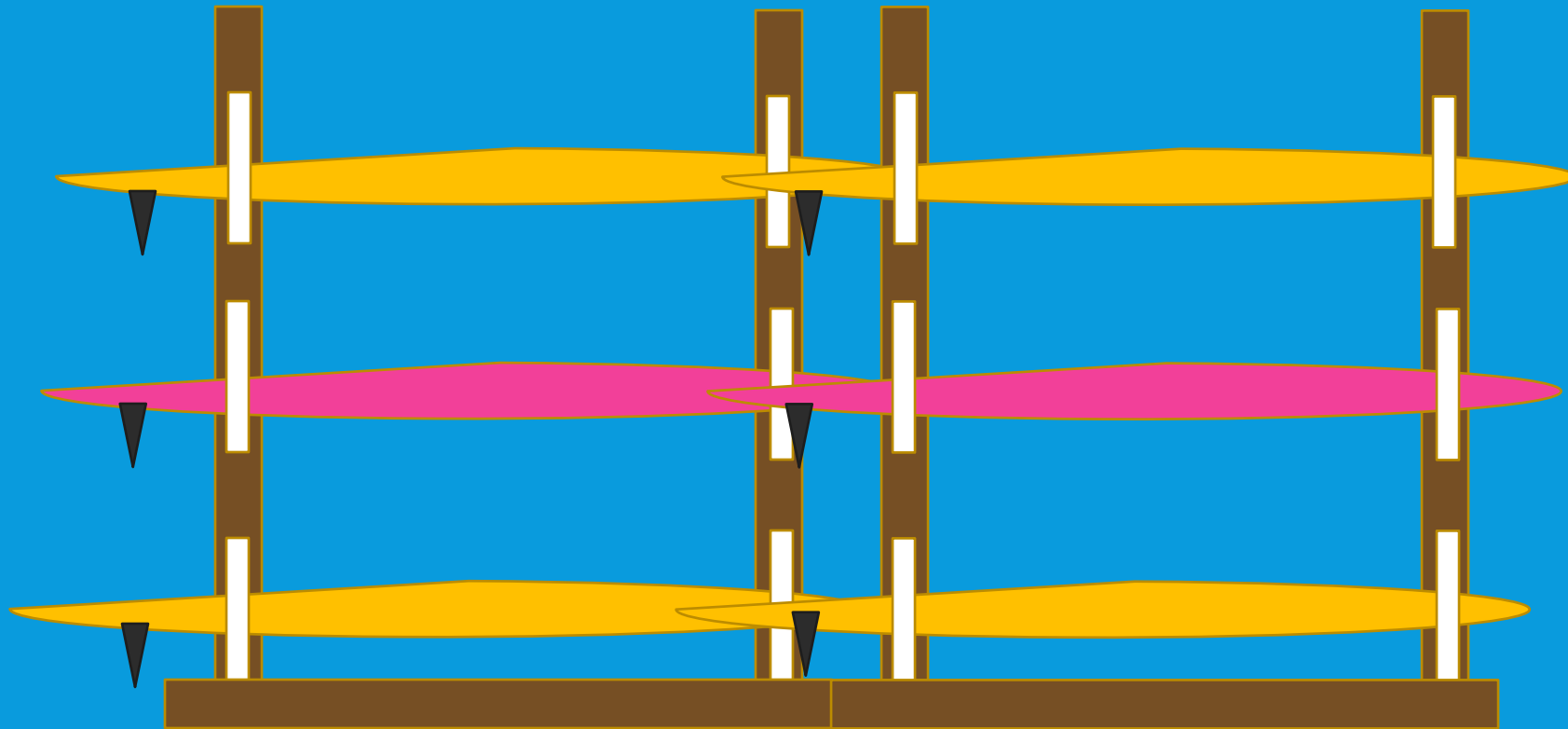
